Business Portion of meeting/Officers and Committee chairs reports

1. Kenny Roberts, President

Kenny welcomed the members to the meeting at Lost Forty. He asked if there were any corrections or additions to the 3-10-16 CAF meeting minutes. There were none. Graham Linder made a motion for the 3-10 minutes to be accepted. Richard Rasmussen seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Kenny shared with the members that the CAF web site update has been updated to include a link to join, to order shirts, the CAF facebook feed, and other updated content. The CAF shirts are to be paid for directly by the members to the vendor and the member will pick up his or her shirt directly from the vendor. The shirts are \$26 each which is \$14 less than the prior vendor. The shirts come in many colors and styles.
